Again, many students gained GCSE's in Art, English, Maths and Science, along with Entry Level Certificates (ELC) in a range of other subjects including Design and Technology, Geography, History, PSE, Food Studies and IT. Students were also awarded the ASDAN award with the majority achieving the Silver award but some also achieving the Gold award.

Although the Average Point Score (APS) was slightly lower than last year, the number of students getting 5+ ELC was higher than last year, meaning students have left Brent Knoll with more qualifications than last year. Also the proportion of students sitting GCSE exams has risen from last year.

All students entered for GCSE's in Art and Science achieved a grade from A* to G with one student in Art achieving a B grade and another student in science achieving a C grade.

The majority of students have secured places at post-16 provision.

Ofsted were impressed with the curriculum offer at KS4 and the results we achieve.
