The equipment enables children who need additional sensory input to interact with sound, light and images in a way that has not been possible previously.

Many people attended the Trust launch lunch at Watergate School earlier this term and a good time was had by all. The Trust is taking shape with Co-operative membership up to nearly 150 and the benefits of our partnerships are being seen in many ways including the development of speech and language therapy and occupational therapy provision at the school and the curriculum enrichment activities being created through Widehorizons.
