Swimming and water safety attainment levels



It is a requirement from The Department for Education for schools to publish how many Year 6 pupils have met the national curriculum requirements relating to swimming and water safety.

By the end of Year 6 children should be able to:

- swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres
- use a range of strokes effectively (breast stroke, back stroke, front crawl)
- perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations be able to perform a safe self-rescue.

Details of the number of children who have met curriculum objectives in Year 6 can be found below:
