1. Legislation and statutory guidance

- 1.1 Governing boards of maintained schools must have an instrument of government which sets out information about how the board is constituted. This requirement is set out in the <u>School Governance</u> (Constitution) (England) Regulations 2012, part 5, regulation 28.
- 1.2 This model instrument of government is based on the model document in the Department for Education's statutory guidance, <u>The Constitution of Governing Bodies of Maintained Schools</u>.

2. Instrument of government

- 1. The name of the school is Brent Knoll School
- 2. The school is a Foundation Special School
- 3. The name of the governing board is 'The governing board of Brent Knoll School'
- 4. The governing board shall consist of:
 - a. 3 parent governors
 - b. 1 local authority governor
 - c. 1 staff governor
 - d. 1 headteacher
 - e. 3 foundation governors
 - f. 3 co-opted governors
- 5. The total number of governors is 12
- 6. The term of office for governors is 4 years
- 7. Brent Knoll and Watergate Co-operative Trust is entitled to appoint foundation governors.
- 8. Brent Knoll School is a member of Brent Knoll and Watergate Co-operative Trust which has legal title to the school's assets which it holds for the purposes or benefits of the school.
- 9. This instrument of government comes into effect on 02/04/2015
- 10. This instrument was made by order of The London Borough of Lewisham on 14/01/2015

A copy of the consolidated instrument will be supplied free of charge to every member and associate member of the governing board (including the headteacher where they are not a governor).

A copy will also be supplied free of charge to the trustees of Brent Knoll and Watergate Co-operative Trust.
